TVF awards a Toolkit Grant of grant of £1,000 to a widening participation medical student and care leaver.

The Victoria Foundation normally awards Toolkit Grants and Elective Bursaries of c£500 but made this higher award due to the exceptional circumstances the high achieving and outstanding medical student has faced. TVF has pledged an annual grant of £1,000 until he completes his studies.



TVF awards Toolkit Grants and Elective Bursaries to over fifty medical students each year from lower socio-economic backgrounds to help cover the cost of textbooks, study materials, medical equipment and travel to hospital or elective placements.

The grants TVF awards are possible in part through the investment of a generous legacy the charity has received from the Estate of Mr CAW Blackwell and a generous donation received from Mr Peter Willson MBBS BSc FRCS (gen). The Victoria Foundation is truly grateful for these wonderful gifts which help enable the charity to award grants to support widening participation students who are also facing great financial pressures during their studies.

Widening participation in medicine aims to ensure that the NHS is reflective and understanding of the needs of its patients in the future.


