# TVF has awarded a grant of £2,500 towards an all-terrain specialist buggy for TAG Youth Club for Disabled Young People

TAG has developed its activities over the last few years and has become a leading short breaks provider in the local community. Membership has grown over 128% within the last two years and the needs of the young people are greater. TAG is supporting more children who are wheelchair users and those with mobility needs.

The buggy designed by disabled people for disabled people can be used on the beach, in the woods and on the snow which will help to ensure the all the youngsters attending TAG groups can take part in all the activities.

TVF has awarded a grant of £798 to fund a Naipo massage chair with lying position for a local resident



"Please send a huge thank you to The Victoria Foundation for approving to buy me this massage chair. I have suffered with severe back and leg pains which prevented me from being able to stay on my feet for long periods of time. The chair will change my life for the better as it will give me a massage to help with the pain - I hope I won't have any more suffering. I haven't taken many pain killers since I have had the chair now as the chair helps me to relax my muscles. It also helps me to stand up on my own."

# TVF has awarded a grant of £13,000 towards new custom playground structure for Clarendon Primary Centre.

Clarendon Primary Centre, based in Hampton, is a special school for pupils with moderate learning needs, many of whom have additional complex needs including Autism. The current playground structure is not fit for purpose and is unsuitable for the 50 primary (4-11 years old) aged pupils who use the playground at least three times per day as it is too big in scale, too small in capacity and does not meet the physical or developmental needs of many of the pupils. The new playground structure is currently being installed – please look out for an
